  - S.A.P.S.** Sgt. Moolman read the crime stats. For Sector 2 and pointed out that most house break-ins were during the day. Theft out of motor vehicles and theft of motor vehicles – at present mostly on Mondays. Dunville Rd. no problems as they have Neighbourhood Watch which works very well. Pick n Pay have kindly agreed to have Sgt. Moolman display a board detailing the crime areas for the public.

being attended to.  
Stop & search system, vehicle check point and road blocks  
are in operation.  
Sector 3 house break-ins on the increase  
Sector 3 meetings – every second week.

Prof. Baker praised Insp. Wiekus & Sgt. Moolman for their  
detailed report and explaining the mapped areas pin  
pointing the crime.

**Metro Police:** Sgt. Maharajh read his stats. and advised that drivers  
speeding and heavy duty trucks offenders are being fined.

**Eric:** Eric presented certificates to Sgt. Maharajh & Sgt.  
Moolman in appreciation of their hard work and help to  
the community.

**Public:** A member of the public inquired as to the ins & outs if one  
is involved in a accident where a person is intoxicated. If  
the intoxicated person is taken away in an ambulance,  
always ask and note the medics names.  
Otherwise, at the scene – breathalysers are taken, the  
District Surgeon is called and blood tests are taken.
