Five building projects taking place at present in Oriel Road and One in Dunville Road. Approximately 40 workers involved.

Watch out for stones, coloured bottles left on verges and in some cases painting around lamp posts. If a bottle is seen lying on your verge with head pointing towards your house could mean you are being targeted. Check verges and entrances every day, pick up foreign matter that may be lying there. Rubbish is thrown out of cars, pedestrians drop rubbish on their way past or something could have been put there intentionally. It is advisable to pick up any foreign matter.

Mr. Heath from Metro Police attended the meeting. The Chairman suggested the Metro Police go to the intersection by the Dutch Reform Church, as a lot of money could be made by fining motorists who were not stopping at the intersection and taxis in a bad state. Ron White queried what could one carry for their own protection. It was advised to carry a shocking stick or pepper spray. Chairman could organize for a lady selling pepper spray to attend our next meeting. When approaching a home with automatic gates and the gates do not open it is advisable to drive past and return. If coast is clear then get out of car to investigate the problem. Be alert when having to stop at the robot of the pedestrian crossing in Bluff Road near the old age home. It has been known for people to hide behind trees and trying to hi jack cars when stopped for the red robot. Municipality to be approached to cut grass opposite St. Barnabas Church. The meeting closed and the floor handed over to Sgt. Moolman for the Sector 2 meeting.
